

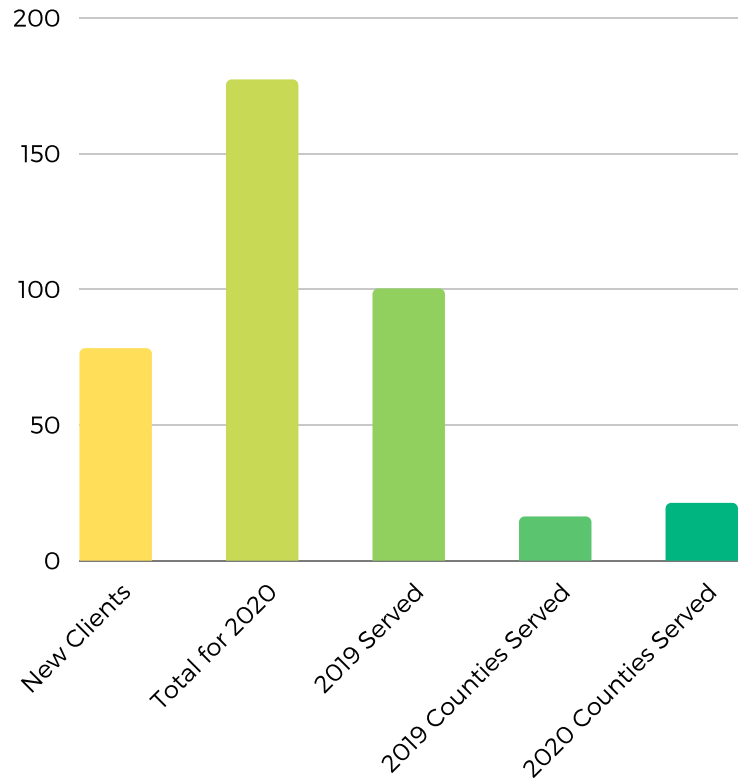
Into the Light

ANNUAL REPORT 2020

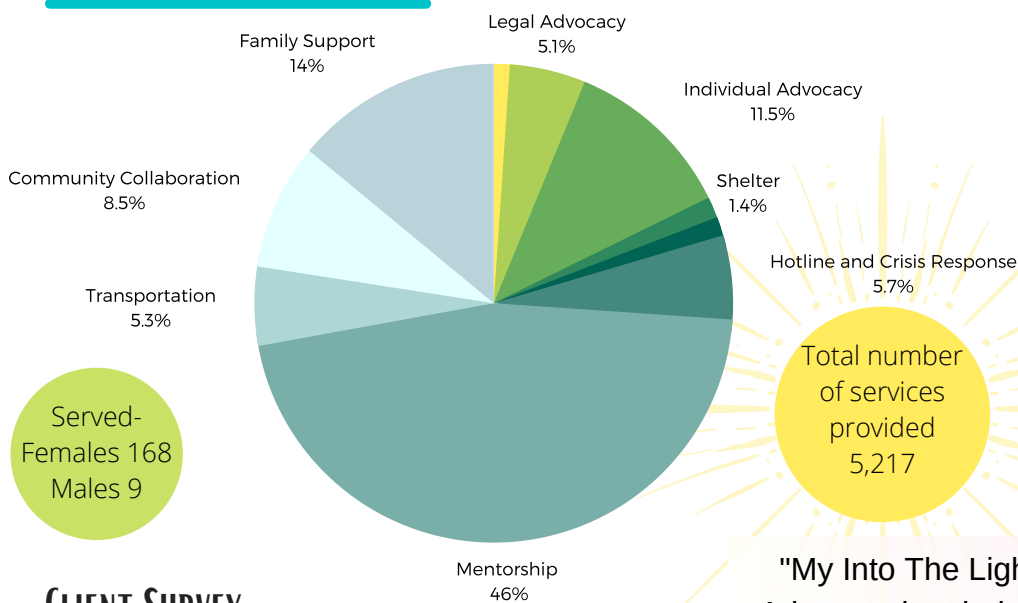
In 2020 your generous support has caused more light than ever to illuminate the lives of minor sexually exploited and trafficked victims.

Many seeds sown have come to fruition this year with law enforcement partners requesting a record number of services for victims. In addition, because of your generosity; ITL assisted over 30 actively trafficked victims to leave "the life" with traffickers and begin their healing journey.

In addition, you helped provide in-person crisis intervention to 145 sexually exploited minors, assisting them in devising a safety plan so they are less vulnerable to the dangers typically associated with sexual exploitation, including violence, traffickers, suicide, drugs, alcohol, and child pornography. 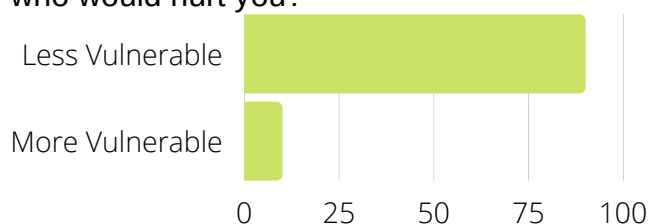
SERVICES PROVIDED

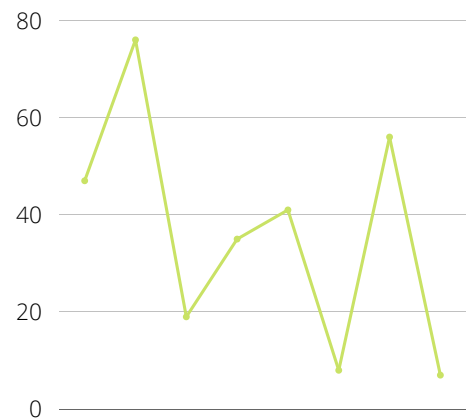
Victims of Crime Act, a federal grant- *We are grateful for this funding, however we hope to become less dependent upon the government in the future.*
