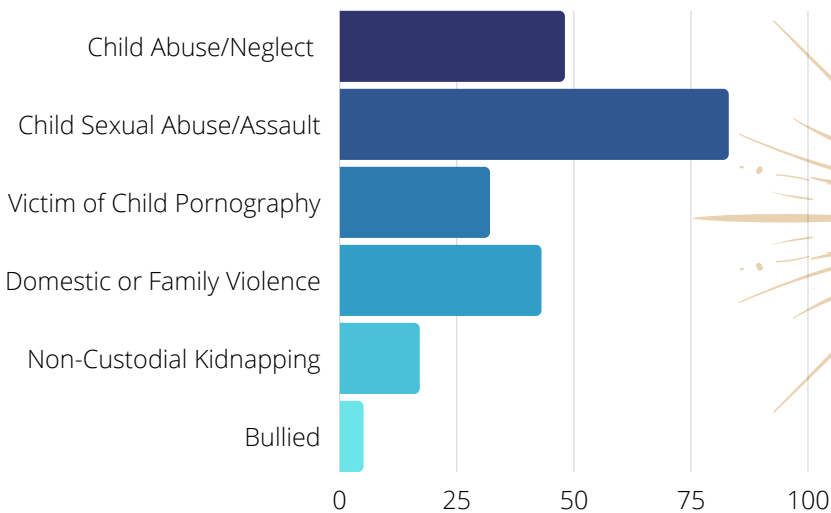
In 2021 your generous support has caused more light than ever to illuminate the lives of minors sexually exploited and trafficked in Arkansas.

The average life span for a human trafficking victim after exploitation begins is 7 years. Your support provided 165 victims truly lifesaving, Christ-centered services.

In addition, you helped provide in-person crisis intervention to 65 sexually exploited minors, assisting them in devising an immediate safety plan so they are less vulnerable to the dangers associated with traffickers, including further exploitation, explicit images of them being used online, violence, suicide, drugs and alcohol addiction.
