Into The Light was founded in 2015 to provide refuge and restoration for minor survivors of sexual exploitation and to bring awareness and education to the issue of human sex trafficking.

When a child is trafficked, there is much to overcome. Often a history of child abuse and neglect prior to their trafficking creates a dark web of hopelessness; but with the help of the caring Arkansas community, the healing light of Christ is shining into their lives.

In the last 12 months, 99 minor victims have begun or continued to heal, becoming survivors who can fully recover from sexual exploitation. 163 victims were met with crisis intervention assisting them with an immediate safety plan, and strategies to make them less vulnerable to dangerous traffickers/buyers, further exploitation, explicit images of them being used online, physical harm, suicide, drugs and alcohol addiction. Because of you, the mighty team of ITL Advocates provide vital, ongoing support to survivors during their healing journey.
